

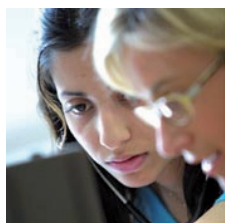

Learning objectives

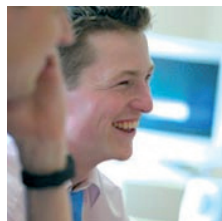
